Enrollment Steps

- 1 Submit an application:** Create an **enrollment portal** account to fill out an application. Be sure to select Destinations Career Academy of Oregon as your school when entering your information!
- 2 Send a letter of intent:** To enroll your student, you will need to submit a **Letter of Intent** by email to your Resident District. Please copy **ordcafax@K12.com** on the email so our school has the required proof that your Resident District has been notified.
- 3 Gather your supporting documents and upload them to the enrollment portal.**
Things you'll need:
 - Your student's birth certificate
 - Proof of residency, such as a utility bill showing your name and address
 - Medical records, i.e., immunization records or exemption (required for public school enrollment)
 - Student transcripts from any previous school attendance
- 4 Receive approval**
 - Check your email for important information about your enrollment status and next steps.
 - If your student is currently enrolled in school, they should remain enrolled while your application is processed and approved.
